Cleancloth was created in 2005 as the Wiper Distribution Division of Trans-Continental Textile Recycling Ltd. (1990). Trans-Continental, working primarily in partnership with local charities, schools, and nonprofit organizations, collects, sorts and distributes wearable used clothing worldwide. Those items unwearable **Cleancloth** processes into wiping materials.



HOW WE DO IT



Clothing is collected from our many community partners, then brought to one of our state of the art textile sorting facilities, located in Vancouver and Calgary.

With help from our 200 foot long sorting conveyors, we process over 60,000 pounds of textiles a day. From there, renewable items like jackets, pants, shirts, shoes, dresses, shorts and sweaters are sorted and packaged for shipment to various people and destinations around the world.

For instance, we can deliver a T-shirt to a port in Africa, for as little as 14 cents.

The materials that cannot be renewed, are processed into custom wiping materials. Our wipers are hand-cut on site, thus allowing us to control the quality and cost in order to pass the savings to you, the customer. Our combined effort, directly relates and supports Trans-Continental Textile Recycling Ltd.'s vision.
